stepped on an Improvised Explosive Devices (IED), suspected to be planted by the insurgents exploded, killing two vigilantes, while two others were injured.

Confirming the encounter between the vigilance and the terrorists in Shuwa, the Caretaker Chairman of Chibok Local Government Area, Mr. Yaga Yarakawa, said:

"Several Boko Haram members were killed, while many others sustained various degree of injuries, but unfortunately, we lost two vigilance group members in the process.

"My gallant vigilantes yesterday went out on patrol and had a fierce encounter with Boko Haram in Shuwa village of Damboa Local Government Area.

Two of the vigilance group members were killed when they stepped on landmines, while scores of the insurgents were also killed and injured."
