One killed in Ibadan as youths, police dash

1 There was pandemonium at the popular Olomi area of Ibadan yesterday when some youths apprehended a man, Taaheed Musiliu, with a human head found in a bag in his possession.

While trying to prevent the police from taking Musiliu away, the youth allegedly attacked the police. One of the youths was killed in the process.

Vigilant youths saw Musiliu with a plastic bag dripping with blood. He was apprehended by the youth between Omiyale and Olomi 7up. Musiliu was about to be lynched when some policemen

intervened and attempted to take him away, but the irate youth prevented the police by blocking the street and pelting the police with stones.

In the melee, the police were said to have fired into the crowd and a stray bullet hit one of the youths who died on the spot.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), SP Adekunle Ajisebutu, said that the suspect who was already in their custody was actually caught with a human head.

He, however, said 27 youths who attacked the police had been arrested.

Ajisebutu said the Criminal Investigation and Intelligence Department (CIID) had begun investigation into the incident.
