

Four Die In Kogi Auto Crash

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Four people have been reportedly killed in a ghastly motor accident along Okene-Lokoja yesterday morning.

The accident, which was said to have occurred at about 12 midnight at Irepeni Village in Adavi Local Government Area of the state, involved 17 other people out of whom four male children sustained varying degrees of injury.

The accident, according to the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), involved two vehicles, a white colour Toyota Hiace bus with registration number 14B 888 DT and an unmarked black Peugeot 206.

The bus, which belongs to Delta Line was said to be fully loaded with commuters heading towards Abuja, while the Peugeot car was coming from Lokoja.

The Kogi State Sector Command of the Federal Road Safety Corps, Mr. Olusegun Martins, while confirming the accident said no fewer than 23 people were involved in the accident of whom two escaped without injury.

He said that those victims with serious injuries were taken to the State Specialist Hospital and Cross Nation Hospital in Lokoja, the Kogi State capital.
