

Three Die In Rival Cult Groups' Clash



At least three persons were killed while others were injured during a clash between two rival cult groups at Agbarho in Ughelli North Local Government Area of Delta State.

It was learnt that the clash, which started at night on the fateful, spilled till the following morning. But it has caused anxiety among the residents of Agbarho for fear of being attacked in their homes.

The three persons who lost their lives were identified as Ochuko popularly known as Sixteen, Favour and Chukwuma, said to be roving photographer.

Speaking with our correspondent on the issue, the Director of Communication, Nigeria Youth Organisation, Sir Patrick Evuarherhe, said cult activities had reduced in the community since the inception of the administration. He said: "So, one cannot ascertain what led to this renewed cult clash.

I believe that the community is doing its best to curtail the activities of these cultists and apart from that, security is everybody's duty." According to Evuarherhe, youths now want to make money and put on the best clothes and shoes but they don't want to work.

He added: "What they do today is that they use the name of cultism to go into robbery." At press time, policemen and vigilantes were combing every nook and cranny of Agbarho in search of the cultists.
