

Passenger Hacks Okada Rider To Death In Enugu

It was a tale of at woe at Umuogbuagu Enugu Ezike, in Igboeze North Local Government Area of Enugu State as an Okada passenger allegedly murdered a motorcyclist at night on Saturday.

The deceased, 40-year-old Sunday Eze, met his untimely death when he was conveying his passenger whose name was given as Michael Gabriel of Enugu Ezike in Igboeze North Local Government Area of Enugu State.

According to police image maker, Ebere Amaraizu, it was learnt that on that fateful day, being February 2, 2017, at about 9pm, the deceased person was conveying a passenger later identified as one Michael Gabriel who allegedly hit him with an iron rod on his head over a yet to be established issue which made the knocked the motorcyclist unconscious.

The victim was, however, rushed to a local hospital, St. Mary's Hospital located within the axis where he was later confirmed dead by the doctor on duty.

Meanwhile, a full scale investigation has commenced into the unfortunate incident as the suspect is helping the operatives of the command in their investigation, Amaraizu disclosed.
