



Kidnappers kill lady, abduct NHIS auditor

Gunmen believed to be kidnappers killed a yet-to-be-identified woman on Saturday evening while they abducted an external auditor of the National Health Insurance Scheme (NHIS) Zakari Mohammed Sada, on the Kaduna-Abuja Expressway.

Sada is a former board member of the Fiscal Responsibility Commission.

This happened a few weeks after police deployed 600 officials of the Special Anti-Kidnap Squad on the Abuja-Kaduna/Zaria-Kano highways.

Sada, family sources said, was kidnapped alongside former Chairman of the defunct NAL Bank, Muftahu Baba-Ahmed.

Sada was travelling from Abuja to Kaduna when he was stopped by the kidnappers around Katari area at 5p.m. on Saturday. The ensuing fracas before his abduction was said to have led to the death of a lady, who is yet to be identified.

Sources said the kidnappers opened fire on travellers in the Katari area, killing the woman before whisking Sada away.

The family has been in contact with the kidnappers who demanded undisclosed sums of money as ransom.

When contacted, the Assistant Superintendent of Police, Mustaoaha Mohammed, who is standing in for the Kaduna State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Aliyu Usman, promised to get back to our correspondent.

He, however, did not call back at the time of filing this report.

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
