

# Alleged murder: Police Commission dismisses CSP, recalls 4 officers

**T**he Police Service Commission (PSC) yesterday, approved the dismissal of a Chief Superintendent of Police (CSP), for the alleged murder of a civilian in Igboeze South Local Government Area of Enugu State.

A statement by the PSC's Head, Press and Public Relations, Mr. Ikechukwu Ani, said the officer, whose name was not disclosed, had shot and killed his victim, whom he had branded an armed robber.

Ani further disclosed, that the commission also approved the reinstatement of a Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP), two Corporals, as well as a Constable, who had been punished for various offences.

This was as he added that a Chief Superintendent of Police (CSP), and two Assistant Superintendents of Police (ASPs), had their punishment of severe reprimand approved.

Ani noted that the decisions were reached at the 23rd Plenary Meeting of the Commission held in Abuja, and presided over by its Chairman, Sir, Mike Okiro.

"The Police Service Commission has approved the dismissal of a Chief Superintendent of Police, CSP, for unlawful exercise of authority, discreditable conduct and

for raising false report. The senior Police Officer was said to have shot and killed an innocent citizen in Igboeze South Local Government Area of Enugu State and planted a gun on his victim which he branded an armed robber.

"The commission also approved the reinstatement of a, Deputy Superintendent of Police, DSP, two Corporals and a Constable.

"The commission also approved the punishment of sever reprimand to another Chief Superintendent of Police, CSP, and two Assistant Superintendents of Police, ASP, for various offences unbecoming of their respective offices and reprimand for one other Assistant Superintendent. It approved warning letter for another ASP.
