

Herdsmen kill school headmaster, NNPC official

Suspected armed Fulani herdsmen have killed a primary school headmaster of Tiv extraction at LGEA Primary School, Umalai, Kadarko in Keana Local Government Area of Nasarawa State, Mr. Augustine.

The herdsmen also killed an official of the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation (NNPC) in Benue State while working on the petroleum pipeline at Tse Torkula in Guma Local Government Area. Tse Torkula is a border community between Nasarawa and Benue states.

Younger brother of the headmaster, Hon. Matyondo John, told our correspondent that his brother was shot in the head. He said the headmaster's remains had been deposited at the General Hospital mortuary at North Bank in Makurdi. Matyondo regretted the incessant killings of the Tiv people in Nasarawa State by armed Fulani herdsmen.
