Police arrest eight over fresh cult killings in ljebulgbo





Police in Ogun State have arrested eight suspected cult members over renewed cult violence in Ijebu-Igbo in Ijebu North Local Government Area of the state. Recovered from the suspects are two pump action guns, four locally made double barrel pistols, eleven live cartridges and assorted charms. This came as one person was again hacked to death in the town in a reprisal attack on Friday morning.

Saturday Telegraph gathered that the arrest followed the reported killing of three persons on Wednesday during a clash between rival cult groups in some parts of the town.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Abimbola Oyeyemi, who had earlier confirmed that only one person was hacked to death in the renewed bloodletting, said yesterday that eight principal suspects were apprehended in connection with the incident. Oyeyemi, an Assistant Superintendent of Police, disclosed that the arrested suspects were members of Aiye and Eiye confraternity.
