80-year-old mother runs mad as p down son





On May 10, policemen stormed Makoko community at Yaba, Lagos State, shot, maim killed residents. When the law enforcement agents were through, they left sorrow, te blood. Two persons lay dead while many others sustained injuries. Wailing and mour enveloped the coastal community.

The policemen were believed to have been drawn from the Lagos State Task Force, Al Kidnapping and Cultism Unit and State Criminal Investigations and Intelligence Dep (SCIID), Panti, Yaba.

According to residents, Kolawole was the bread winner of his aged parents.

Kolawole's pregnant wife was shot and injured while attempting to move his 94-year-father out of the way of ricocheting bullets from the policemen's smoking guns. Som policemen wore jackets that had 'Raider' written on them.

They drove into the petrified community on May 10 in eight commercial buses and a Maria. Witnesses claimed that to instil fear in and cowed the residents, the policement shooting sporadically, unmindful where their flying bullets landed.

Fearful for the lives of the elderly and children in the community, enraged youths we to have bravely stepped out of their hiding to confront the shooters.

Kolawole was among young men that attempted to protect his family and community Another person killed was Seyi Akintenehin. One of the residents, Mr. Peter Ipense, s "After the policemen entered the community, they attacked 'The Acts of Apostle Chu

They also set several buildings and about 15 makeshift shops on fire. I guessed they v trying to send a signal to us. On May 4, before the attack, elders in the church had a r with the officer in charge of the Anti-land Grabbing Task Force in his office. He gave to vacate the community.

The elders reminded him that the matter was in court and that they couldn't speak full. The elders told him to exercise patience for the verdict of the court. "We were in cl May 10, about 7a.m., when we saw stern looking policemen invade our community.

They came in eight commercial buses and a Black Maria. Before we knew what was hat they had started shooting. Within a few minutes, two of our family members had bee. The two men that were killed each had a pregnant wife.

The operation, which started about 7a.m., ended about 10p.m. They left us in anguisl According to Ipense, after the policemen gained access into the church, they set it on

of the founder of the church to destroy it, but didn't succeed. Ipense said: "They also people's houses to make arrest, collect their phones, money and other valuables. Prestill have not been able to bury one of the victims because they took his corpse away. those who sustained injuries is the pastor of The Acts of Apostles Church, Pastor Rot Inuoshelawo.

He was shot in the leg. Some elderly men and women, who couldn't scamper into safe also alleged to have sustained injuries. Explaining why policemen stormed the comm tried to kick them out, Ipense said: "We gathered that a family, the Cokers, is claimin they are the owners of this land.

But the land belongs to our forefathers who reclaimed the land from the Lagoon to A Our fathers are also paying royalties to Nigerian Maritime Administration and Safety (NIMASA) till date.

My question is where was the Cokers family when our fathers were sandfilling the lar Another resident, Mr. John Peter, said this was not the first time policemen would involve community in an attempt to force them off the land.

He recalled: "On June 12, 2014, the former Deputy Commissioner of Police in charge Operations, Lagos State Police Command, Mr. Tunde Sobulo, led a team of policemer community to chase us away. Nobody died then, but many sustained injuries.

The task force claimed that we built our houses on a disputed parcel of land. But we rethem to understand that some of our mothers, who partook in the sand-filling of the still alive and could testify.

All we want is peace. We don't want to take laws into our hands, which was why we p to the governor's office the other day, to register our displeasure." Mr. Ayodele Akinti also a resident, said: "The case of the land dispute is before the court.

They involved policemen and the community was invaded, leading to the murder of t men."Akintimeyin further said: "Many of our community members were injured and critical conditions at the Mainland General Hospital. Some were shot in the legs. The policemen shot directly at people.

They burnt the church and 15 shops outside the church. Chairs and musical instrume burnt. The policemen were not in uniform. Some of them wore jackets with the inscrifacion. About 2,000 residents had been displaced now." Giving her own account, Da Ogunbekun said that the policemen were clearly for a war. She said: "I was outside we drove into the church premises.

The policemen started shooting and burning shops. I managed to escape through the the church. People were shouting and crying.

There was panic everywhere." Mrs. Ajimuda Mosunmola recollected: "I was sleeping stray bullet flew into my room through the roof of my house. I would have been dead it was God that saved me. I'm part of the generation who sand-filled the Makoko com

We are the rightful owners of this place. Immediately the bullet fell into my room, I r outside, attempting to escape and stay alive. It was when I was going that I fell down sustained injury on my knees. Government should come to our rescue before these pokill all of us."

Mrs. Titilola Olaremoye (80) said: "I'm part of those who sand-filled this community was waterlogged. We were living on the lagoon before everybody moved into this place was sandfilled in the 60s.

Whoever is threatening us today, will not know peace! We suffered to make the place today. We have sacrificed a lot to make the place habitable. It is also a sacrilege for sc burn down the house of God.
