Protest in Edo as JSS3 student is electrocuted



Protests yesterday rocked Muslim community at Eyean in Uhunmwode Local Governi of Edo State following the electrocution of a Junior Secondary School (JSS3) student.

The protesters, who were mainly students of Eyean Community Secondary School, Ey trooped out over the death of the student on the school premises. The victim, identif simply as Benedict, was said to have unknowingly touched a high-tension cable whic down. He was said to have been burnt beyond recognition. It was learnt that the incic occurred while the students were going home after school.

Witnesses said Benedict was going home when he touched a rod from a broken electr when he was electrocuted. Further findings revealed that a vehicle had hit and broken electricity pole which exposed the rod inside the pole, which had contacted the high-cable.

The ugly sight of the dead student had aroused the anger of other students as they bl Benin-Auchi highway, thereby causing gridlock which lasted several hours. The aggri students accused the management of the Benin Electricity Distribution Company (BE causing Benedict's death by not taking steps to fix the broken electric pole.
