

# Trailer crushes another woman in Ibadan, injures many

Barely a week after a trailer crushed and killed a woman at the Molete Roundabout of Ibadan, Oyo State capital, another trailer conveying a container yesterday lost its control and crushed a woman who was yet to be identified while leaving many others injured.

According to an eye witness, who identified himself as Segun Shobo, the tragedy occurred about 8:02am under the Molete Flyover due to brake failure. In the process, about three buses and four tricycles popularly called "Keke NAPEP" were also damaged.

He said: "A truck convey-

ing container, that was coming from Oke Ado heading towards Molete Roundabout lost its brake while trying to negotiate the Roundabout and ran over a Jeep. It also hit an 18-seater bus and left it damaged. The bus which was parked by the roadside was also damaged while, five tricycles were also damaged.

"While trying to save the situation, the truck driver mistakenly knocked down a woman who was yet to be identified as at the time her corpse was taken away from here. Some people said the woman was a roadside petty trader, who was about to set up her petty goods", the eye witness told *Saturday Telegraph*.
