about 30, mobilised and went to Aguda for a reprisal. In yesterday clash, property worth millions

of naira, including parked cars, were destroyed.

A resident, who didn't want his name mentioned. said: "The fracas started as a mere disagreement between two rival youths and later spread like wildfire to Enitan, Adefowope and Willy Omiyi streets in Coker Aguda Council Development Area. Policemen and detachment of military personnel were immediately deployed in the area. The youth used dangerous weapons freely. Security agencies were also seen patrolling and stationed at strategic locations within the community."
