

Edo lawmaker raises the alarm over suspected serial killer in Igueben

A member representing Igueben constituency in the Edo State House of Assembly, Hon. Ephraim Otaigbe Aluebhosole, has cried out over the repeated incident of killings experienced in Igueben by an unknown person believed to be a serial killer. Speaking exclusively to Saturday Telegraph in his GRA house in Benin- City, Aluebhosole called on the relevant security agencies in the state to do everything within their powers to fish out the killer, adding that his people are now living in perpetual fear.

He said: "What is happening in my village in Igueben Local Government Area of Edo State is becoming alarming. It is strange to us that for the past few months three people had been attacked two dead and one of them seriously wounded by an unknown criminal believed to be a suspected serial killer." "Just on August 17, a woman was also killed by the same gang along Bank Road in Idumeka Igueben. As a member representing the constituency I have reported the case to the Division Police Officer (DPO) in Igueben.
