

Five killed in Lagos-Ibadan Expressway crash

Five persons were yesterday killed in a road crash, while 10 others sustained injuries along the Ibadan-Lagos Expressway when the commercial bus conveying them burst into flames.

The Ogun State Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Mr. Clement Oladele, told an online news portal, *PREMIUM TIMES* that the crash occurred about 8.49a.m. around Onigari, a town on the border of Ogun State and Oyo State.

He said the crash involved a commercial bus, which was travelling from Sokoto State but stopped briefly in Ibadan to pick passengers heading towards Lagos.

The bus lost control due to excessive speed, and collided with the concrete curb in the middle of the road and burst into flames.

The commander said the crash involved 18 passengers comprising 17 male adults and one female adult.
