Mobile money agent rapes co-worker to death

Police in Ogun State have arrested a mobile money banking agent, Eniola Adenuga, for allegedly raping his co-worker, Faith Jude, to death.

Adenuga, 27, was among 19 suspected criminals paraded on Wednesday by the state Deputy Commissioner of Police (Operations), Edward Ajogun, at the police command headquarters, Eleweran, Abeokuta.

The suspects also included seven young men arrested for allegedly gang-raping a university graduate after luring her through a social media dating site, InMessage.

Briefing reporters, Ajogun said Adenuga was arrested following professional interrogation despite his ploy to mislead the police.

He explained that the suspect reported on September 19 at the police division in Lafenwa area of Abeokuta that he discovered Faith's lifeless body covered with a canopy in front of his mobile money banking office.

However, the suspect later confessed to the crime during interrogation, saying he had been on the trail of the 21-year-old victim for a date prior to the incident.

The police boss said it was discovered that there were marks of violence on the deceased body which raised the suspicion that she was murdered.

Ajogun said the case had been referred to the homicide section of the command's Criminal Investigation Department.

Speaking with our correspondent, Adenuga stated that he had sex with the victim despite the fact that she was having her monthly period.

He said Faith, who recently joined the mobile money banking office, came to him during a heavy rain and he requested to have sex with her but she declined.

Adenuga said, notwithstanding, he forcefully had his way and raped the lady, who gave up the ghost in the process.
