

Mother, son killed by kidnappers for burial Nov 1

The family of a woman and her son murdered by rampaging kidnappers has announced the burial of the deceased for November 1. The woman, whose name was given as Mrs Awotongha Nelly Ala-Binte and her son, Tarilate Edwin Ala-Binte, will be buried in Port Harcourt, Rivers State on the date.

According to a poster for the two signed by the husband and father of the deceased as well as the woman's maternal and paternal families, a number of events will precede the

burial on the first day in November.

The son, who was 22 years old at the time of his gruesome death along with his mother, was a final year student of Afe Babalola University, Ado Ekiti, Ekiti State.

Saturday Telegraph gathered that he was on his way to finishing his studies as the Best Graduating Student of Petroleum Engineering at the private university.

As such, a Candle Light in honour of the young man, who was described as a torch bearer and hero,

will hold simultaneously at the Afe Babalola University on November 1.

For his 54-year-old mother, married to Elder Igbogifurotogu J. Ala-Binte, the opening of a Mourning House at 23, Oju Daniel Kalio Street in Bioma, Bokokiri, Port Harcourt, Rivers State between October 29 and November 1

A procession will also hold, taking off at 1, Aggrey Road to All Saints Christ Church Int'l in Borokiri, Port Harcourt.
