

NAF jet destroys Boko Haram's gun trucks in Borno

The Nigerian Air Force (NAF) says its Air Task Force (ATF) of Operation LAFIYA DOLE has destroyed two Boko Haram terrorists' gun trucks and killed some fighters at Borgozo in Borno.

According to News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) report, NAF explained that this was achieved when NAF jets and a helicopter gunship were scrambled to pro-

vide close air support to ground troops as they repelled a BHT attack on the location.

"The aircraft, upon arrival overhead the target area, tracked and engaged three of the BHT gun trucks that were involved in the attack.

"The BHTs moved the vehicles under some trees, while some of the fighters alighted from the vehicles and attempted to escape

into the surrounding bushes.

"The attack aircraft engaged them, scoring accurate hits on two vehicles, which were seen engulfed in flames, and neutralising some of the fleeing terrorists," he said.

NAF also disclosed that operating in concert with surface forces, would sustain its efforts to completely destroy all remnants of terrorism in the North East.
