Driver kills two, injures three on Lagos-Ibadan Expressway

Two pedestrians were killed by a Honda SUV which drove against the traffic around Ibafo area on Lagos-Ibadan Expressway on Christmas Day.

The Ogun State Sector Commander of Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Mr. Clement Oladele, told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) yesterday that three others were injured in the accident.

Oladele said that a Honda Element SUV, with registration number KSF 946 DB, drove against the traffic and knocked down two pedestrians waiting to board a commercial bus, killing them instantly and injuring three others.

The FRSC official attributed the cause of the accident to route violation and speeding leading to loss of control.

He said: "The corpses of the victims have been deposited at Fakoya Hospital, Sagamu, while the survivors are receiving treatment at Idera Hospital, Sagamu, Ogun State."

Oladele advised motorists to desist from driving against traffic and adhere strictly to traffic rules and regulations, to avoid unnecessary loss of lives and property.
