

Robbers kill man going to vigil, steal his phones

Detectives have arrested three suspects for allegedly killing a 50-year-old man, Kayode Babalola, who was going to vigil at Ketu area of Lagos State.

The victim was said to have left his office at Oregun on the fateful day for Ketu when he was attacked by the suspects.

The suspects were identified as Damilare Abimbola (25), Paul Peter (22) and Rasaki Ibrahim (22). It was learnt that after attacking him, the suspects threw his remains into a canal in the area.

The state Commissioner of Police, Hakeem Odumosu, said the robbers Babalola's two phones and other valuables.

Odumosu said the victim's family members were still searching for the body of the victim, while the suspects confessed to the crime.

Police also arrested a suspected highway robber terrorising the residents of Ise/Epe area of the state.

The suspect, said to be the ring-leader of the syndicate, identified as Moshood Abayomi, was arrested by the operatives from Rider Section of the State Criminal Investigations and Intelligence Department (SCIID), Pantti, Yaba.
