

Auto crash claims one in Ekiti

Residents of Aramoko in Ekiti West Local Government of Ekiti State were yesterday thrown into mourning when a native of the town was killed in an auto accident due to over speeding by the reckless car driver. Barely a week ago, three people died along the axis also in a road accident. It was gathered that the driver of the vehicle was driving on a top speed when he collided with a motorcycle, killing the passenger on the spot while the bike man was rushed to the hospital.

People of Aramoko became emotionally pained as they found the sadness of losing their loved one unbearable. The people took to the street on protest, barricaded the major road in the community, while commuters and motorists got stranded in the process. When contacted, the Public Relations Officer Ekiti State Command, Sunday Abutu, confirmed the incident, adding that the driver was currently in the police custody for further investigation.
