

Members of one of the rival groups had shot sporadically along the Three House area at Upper Sakponba area thereby forcing more than 30 persons to hide inside a shop.

At Third East Circular Road junction near Murtala Mohammed Way, four suspected cult members were mowed down in gruesome manner while others were killed in different parts of the city.

It was learnt that some suspects arrested in connection with last year's cult killings especially two leaders of Eiye and Aye confraternities were released last month.

Policemen were later deployed to the trouble areas of the Third East Circular Road junction where they arrested some suspected cult members.



Residents of the area accused the policemen of arresting traders and artisans on the excuse that they were members of the rival cult groups.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Chidi Nwabuzor, yesterday said he was yet to be briefed on the cult killings.

Nwabuzor said the police had right to randomly arrest people within the vicinity of crime, screen them and release those found to be innocent.



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
