

Gunmen murder vigilante in Ondo

Herdsmen suspected to be Fulani yesterday murdered a vigilante in Ondo town in Ondo East Local Government Area of Ondo State.

The 58-year-old security man, Mr. Kasali Ajeigbe, was said to have met his death in the hands of his assailants while returning home from his place of work.

The brother of the deceased, Saheed Ajeigbe, explained that the deceased was overpowered by the herdsmen who slit his throat with a knife.

Saheed disclosed that his brother was waiting for a taxi after closing from the sawmill where he was working, when the Fulani herdsmen attacked him.

He said: “My late brother went to his duty post and when he was returning home and waiting for taxi by the road, he was attacked.

“Some Fulani, who were being chased by some policemen from Oke-Igbo where they went to rob, attacked him and slit his throat with their knife.

“Policemen came and rushed him to the hospital where he was confirmed dead and his body deposited at the mortuary.”

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), ASP Tee-Leo Ikoro, said the command had commenced investigation into the matter.

Ikoro, however, said there was no proof that the man was killed by herdsmen.

But the PPRO promised that the command would soon bring the perpetrators of the crime to book.
