man, Remigius Obieshieke, has been allegedly murdered by his siblings over a quarrel arising from money generated from the burial of their 75-year-old mother, Angelina Obieshieke.

The said siblings – Patrick Obieshieke, Chinonso Obieshieke and John Erieka – all of the Umuosochie Autonomous Community at Obowo in Imo State have gone into hiding.


The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), SP Orlando Ikeokwu, confirmed this in a statement.

He said: "On May 22, 2020 about 6a.m., upon credible information, operatives of the Divisional Police Headquarters, Obowo, moved to Umuolowoshe, Umuosochie Autonomous Community, Obowo, and it was discovered that the said suspects had killed one Remigius Obieshieke during a disagreement arising from money realised from the burial of their mother, Angelina Obieshieke, 75 years old."

Ikeokwu said machinery had been put in place to arrest the fleeing suspects, while investigation had commenced in earnest.


