Five arrested nine months after father of three's murder

Personnel of the Force Criminal Investigations Department (FCID), Abuja, have arrested five suspects in connection with the murder of a land agent, Yemi Taiwo, on September 8, 2020 in Lagos State.

Taiwo, a father of three, was murdered four days after he and another man, Femi Animasaun, were abducted at the <u>Isiwu</u> area of Ikorodu, Lagos State.

The arrested suspects are identified as Ola Tijani, Michael James, Ahmed Kasumu, Tunde James and Kose aka 'Sharp Shooter'.

The five men were arrested after the police reviewed the video when the victims were being tortured by the suspects, which led to Taiwo's death.

The arrest followed a directive from the office

of the Inspector General of Police to the FCID after a petition from the representatives of the survivor of the torture, Femi Animasaun, and Taiwo's widow, Mrs. Olabisi Taiwo.

The suspects were identified in the viral video of the dehumanising torture of Taiwo and Animasaun on the premises of the Secretariat of the Ikorodu North Local Government Area.
