

Kwara: Five in police net for alleged money rituals

Kwara state Police Command has arrested five suspects who allegedly killed a woman for money rituals.

The suspects, according to a statement by the Command's spokesman, Sp Okasanmi Ajayi, are Samuel Peter Tsado, Mohammed Gbara a.k.a. Madi, Abubakar Mohammed a.k.a. Mallam

Baba Pati, Mohammed Ahmadu Nma, and Bala Karin, adding that three others are at large.

The statement also confirmed the recovery of the remains of the murdered victim, simply identified as Abigail, saying the suspects would be charged to court at the conclusion of investigation.

The statement said: "The Commissioner of Police Kwara State, CP Tuesday Assayomo psc+ wishes to inform the general public of the Command's breakthrough in the investigation of a reported case of missing person turned homicide. On 29/6/2021 at about 2308hrs, an unknown young person later identified as Samuel Peter Tsado 'm' of Patigi town in Patigi Local government area of Kwara State, went to one Victory Hotel Patigi and requested for the service of a commercial sex worker by name Abigail 'f' other names unknown. After the monetary negotiation of #5000:00, both Peter and Abigail left the ho-

tel premises to an unknown place, ever since then both of them were not seen again.

"On the receipt of the report of missing person, the Commissioner of Police who suspected a foul play directed the case be taken over by the State Criminal investigation Department for a discreet investigation.

"Investigation, however, led to the arrest of one Samuel Peter Tsado, who confessed that he actually contracted the deceased for sex, he also confirmed that himself and one Mohammed Agbara 'm' a.k.a. Madi both agreed and planned how to make money ritual and in furtherance of their desires, they planned on how to source for the human head that would be needed for the money rituals which prompted him to leave his house at Patigi for Victory hotel with his motorcycle where he approached the late Abigail, a sex worker, who agreed to follow him home after agreeing on #5000:00 for the night."
