

I wanted to use human head for money ritual - Suspected ritualist

A suspected ritualist, Tunde Olayiwola has said he bought a human head for a sum of N60,000.00 from one of his customers to be used for money making ritual.

Olayiwola, who claimed to be a herbalist with 53 years experience, said he bought the human head from one of his customers in order to use it for wealth ritual.

The Ondo State Police Command yesterday paraded Olayiwola with a fresh human head in Oka, In Ondo West Local Government Area of the state.

Parading the suspect among others,

the Commissioner of Police, Mr Oyeyemi Oyediran said the Police received information that a self-acclaimed cleric named Alfa Tunde Olayiwola 'm' a suspected ritualist was about to receive a consignment suspected to be a human head.

Oyediran said the Police immediately swung into action and the cleric was apprehended at Ajagbale Area of Oka, Ondo town.

He said a fresh human head was found in his custody. He confessed that the head found in his possession was to be used to ensure he had a better life.

However, Olayiwola said he did not have any regret for using human head for ritual purposes. He said if it was his son that was killed for money making ritual, he said that was his end and would do nothing about it.

He refused to give the name of his accomplices saying he wanted to be rich just as his counterparts.

Aside Olayiwola, the Police boss also paraded other suspects including suspected kidnappers, cultists and armed robbers.

Oyediran said based on the recent cult activities and supremacy battle between rival cult groups in Okitipupa, the anti-cultism section took the battle to the area and this led to the arrest of two suspects namely; Mathew Thankgof and Olabokunde Micheal in their hide-out.
