

Police to unmask those behind murder of Unijos female student

The Plateau State Police Command said it has ordered for a discrete investigation to unravel the circumstances surrounding the suspected murder of a 300 level female student of the University of Jos on January 1, 2022.

A 300-level student of the University of Jos, Jennifer Anthony was allegedly murdered by her boyfriend.

The deceased was said to have told her parents in Abuja that she was coming to Jos for a job interview, but ended up in a hotel with a man.

In a video going viral on social media, Jennifer was seen with a young man cruising round town.

However the Police Command Public Relations Officer, ASP Ubah Gabriel Ogaba told New Telegraph in Jos yesterday that the Command is aware of the ugly incident which took place on January 1.

“The Commissioner of Police Plateau State, CP Bartholomew Onyeka has ordered a discrete investigation to unravel the circum-

stances surrounding the incident and to arrest the perpetrators of that dastardly act.

“He also held an emergency meeting with all hoteliers in Plateau State where he gave them security tips on how to man their hotels to avert reoccurrence of such ugly incidents.”

New Telegraph learnt that Jennifer, a 300 level student of Special Education and Rehabilitation Sciences, University of Jos is suspected to be have been murdered by her boyfriend at a hotel in Jos, Plateau State where he lodged on Friday, December 31, 2021.
