

Court remands tailor for allegedly killing neighbour with pestle

A Kaduna Magistrates' Court yesterday ordered the remand of a 29-year-old Kaduna-based fashion designer, Gado Yahaya, for allegedly killing his neighbour.

Yahaya, a resident of Rigasa, Igabi Local Government Area, allegedly killed Liman Salisu during an argument over a bucket of water.

He was arraigned on charges of culpable homicide.

The prosecutor, Inspector Chidi Leo, alleged that Yahaya Gado killed Salisu with a pestle during their fight over a bucket of water.

Leo said: "In the course of the fight, he went into the kitchen, picked a pestle and hit Salisu on his head. He slumped after he was hit on the head and died on the way to the hospital."

According to him, Yahaya wrote and signed a confessional statement when he was brought to

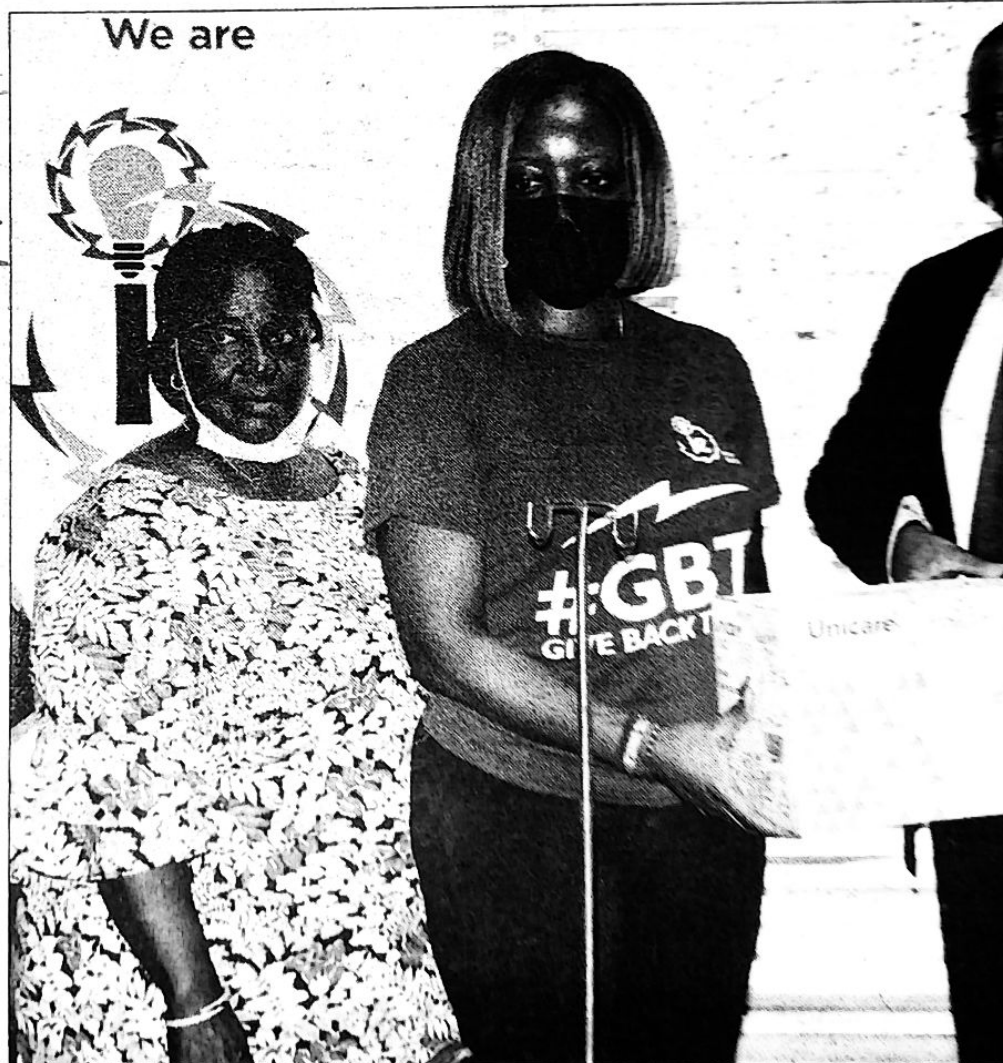
the police station for questioning.

The offence, he said, contravened the provisions of Section 190 of the Penal Code of Kaduna State 2017.

However, the court directed the police to forward the case file to the

State Director of Public Prosecution for legal advice and adjourned the matter to March 9, 2022, for mention.

Chief Magistrate Ibrahim Emmanuel then ordered that Yahaya be remanded in a correctional facility.
