the tragedy which happened on Friday, was reported at the Ninigi Divisional Police Headquarters by the father of the victim, Haruna Shuaibu, aged 38-years old, and he told the Police that his son, Sadisu, had a mental problem.

Wakil said, "We have a case of sudden and unnatural death. On February 18, 2022 at about 12.00hrs, one Haruna Shuaibu, a 38-year old of Dadin Kowa Street, Ningi, reported at the Divisional Police Headquarters, Ningi, that his son, Sadisu Haruna, 14-years old, hanged himself at an uncompleted room in the house.

It was gathered that the fatal accident, which occurred at about 8:00 am yesterday, involved a commercial passenger bus heading towards Lagos and a private Toyota saloon car that was coming out of the airport.

One of the vehicles involved in the crash was said to have carried petrol-filled kegs.

An eye witness account said: "The Toyota saloon car was driving out of the Airport, while the Lagos bound Hiace Bus was on top speed along the expressway. The Bus collided with the car, resulting in loss of control and the bus went up in flames immediately.
