Bus driver kills FRSC official, one other in Ondo

An official of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Abdulkareem Ojonla Jimoh, has been killed by a driver of an 18-seater passenger bus along the Sagamu-Ore-Benin expressway.

The bus driver who was said to have crushed the FRSC official with his white Toyota Hiace bus with registration number NEM618AA also ran over a motorist whose papers were been checked by the road safety operatives.

The head of the Sagamu-Benin corridor for the FRSC, Lasisi Ogundele confirmed the incident which happened some meters from the Ajebandele bridge before the military checkpoint to newsmen.

Ogundele added that the accident was caused by break failure on the part of the bus driver who was coming from the Sagamu end of the road. He said that "the staff, SRMA Abdulkareem Ojonla Jimoh who was on patrol duty was attending to a reasonably suspected traffic offender with vehicle details; Ash Toyota Previa with registration number, SMK-687GG, when the driver of a White Toyota Hiace Bus with registration number, NEM-618AA lost control of his vehicle as a result of a brake failure.

"In an attempt to avoid collision with other vehicles on queue at the checkpoint hit the marshal; the suspected traffic offender being attended to; and two other vehicles.
