

2 Suspected ritualists behead man inside Bayelsa church

Suspected ritualists on Wednesday beheaded a 37-years-old man, Anthony Egbo in Bayelsa State.

The man was said to have been beheaded inside a church located at Elebele community in Ogbia Local Government Area of the state.

The lifeless body of Egbo, who was said to be a security personnel attached to the church, was discovered by the assistant pastor of the

church.

It was gathered that the pastor discovered the mutilated body of the victim, with the head severed from the body.

Confirming the incident, the youth president of Elebele Community, Famous Egbo stated that the deceased was discovered at about 5.50am, adding that when people saw him, his throat was missing.

Also reacting, the Police Public Relations Officer in the state, Asinim Butswat, confirmed the

incident.

Meanwhile, an unidentified vandal was electrocuted in the Osiri area of Yenagoa.

It was gathered that the charred body of the suspected vandal was discovered early morning Wednesday hanging on the electric pole after electrocution. A resident of the area, Pereko Stanley, said the vandal had cut one of the armoured cable but was unfortunate on the second trip with the power coming on and he was electrocuted.
