Two KWASU students found dead inside private hostel

wo 200 level students of the Kwara State University (KWASU), Malete, Tobiloba Daniel and Arewa Abayomi, have been found dead inside their hostel.

He said: "The information was that the two of them (students) were found dead inside their room and the police were alerted.
