

Kwara: Monarch laments invasion of Ibagun/Okelele community by suspected cultists

The Alangua of Ibagun, Okelele, in Ilorin, Kwara State, Mallam Sakariyau Ilufemiloye, has condemned the invasion of the community by cultists, lamenting that two persons

were killed by suspected cultists in the community between Monday and Tuesday.

The Alangua, in a statement signed on his behalf by the Chairman of Ibagun Progressives Union (IPU), Alhaji Kuranga Omomeji Morogun, urged parents and guardians to enlighten their children and wards on the dangers of

being involved in cultism.

He also enjoined the heads of various families in the community to counsel their children against involvement in cultism, while appealing to religious leaders in the area to make preaching against youths involvement in cultism a focal point.
