Man allegedly stabs friend to death for refusing to buy him beer in Bauchi

A 29-year-old man, Monday Ajasco, has allegedly stabbed his friend to death for refusing to buy him beer in Bauchi State.

The suspect, of Kafin Tafawa, now in police custody, allegedly killed Abdularazak Ibrahim, 30, at a beer parlour in Bagel Dass Local Government Area of the state.

This was contained in a press release signed by the Police Public Relation Office, SP Ahmed Wakil and made available to newsmen yesterday in Bauchi.

According to Wakil, the two friends were involved in a heated argument after Ibrahim denied Monday's request to buy him beer,

but after a while both left the beer parlour and went to their homes.

According to an eye witness, he heard Ibrahim screaming and on reaching the scene, met him lying in the pool of blood, while Monday was standing near the victim holding a sharp animal horn in his hand.

The witness said Monday became violent and threatened to stab him, the witness, who is also a friend of the deceased when he asked why he killed his friend.

The Police PRO said Monday allegedly stabbed Ibrahim in the neck with a sharp object suspected to be an animal horn. As a result, he sustained a serious injury and was swiftly rushed to the General Hospital Dass, but was certified dead by a medical doctor.

The Police Public Relations Officer for the command, Ahmed Wakil, said the suspect would be charged to court for prosecution on completion of investigation for culpable homicide.
