

Gunmen kill LP Women Leader, injure husband in Southern Kaduna

A yet-to-be identified gunmen in the early hours of Monday killed Mrs Victoria Chimtex, the Labour Party (LP) Women Leader in Kaura Local Government Area in the southern part of Kaduna State. The attack was confirmed by the zonal secretary of the party, Mr. Edward Buju in a statement

yesterday

The husband of the LP Woman leader was also shot on his leg, but has been rushed to an undisclosed medical facility for treatment.

The Publicity Secretary Zone 3, of the Labour Party, Edward Simon Buju, said: "The Southern Kaduna, Zone 3, Labour Party (LP) family, the Chairman and EXCOs of Kaura Local Government Area (LGA) LP

condemns in strong terms the brutal and cowardly assassination of our Mother and Sister, Mrs Victoria Chimtex, Woman Leader, Kaura LGA LP.

"The sad event took place this morning (Monday) when some unknown gunmen broke into her family resident in Manchok, Kaura LGA and shot her severally to death."

According to him, the "husband was brutally shot in the leg and he is currently in an undisclosed hospital. The killers did not take any valuables in the house, suggesting assassination as the only mission of the wicked actors.

"Mrs Chimtex was known for her ability to relate well with people, an endowment she used in bringing hundreds of resourceful new entrants into the Labour Party in Kaura LGA.

"She was known for her relentless campaign for the 'Obidient' cause and she made a lot of converts."

He said they are saddened by the death of such an industri-

ous, "hard working and dedicated Woman Leader, who was kill when the families of Labour Party from the local government, Zonal and the state needed her the most at this critical time that Nigerians are in quest for a new Nigeria through the Labour Party

"The Zonal leadership of Labour Party in Zone 3, is bereaved at this moment. We are calling on all the members of Labour Party from each polling

Ogun: Native doctor arrested for hacking neighbour to death

Men of the Ogun State Police Command have arrested a native doctor, Idowu Talabi, for allegedly killing his 30-year-old co-tenant, Isau Oluwatobiloba.

The suspect was arrested on Sunday, November 27 for allegedly hacking his neighbour to death with a cutlass in his

death with a machete by an unknown person.

"Upon the report, the DPO Ikenne division, CSP Ibrahim Ningi, led his detectives to the scene, where it was discovered that the deceased was hacked with machete to death while sleeping on his bed.
