Gunmen kill APGA supporter in Ebonyi

Unmen yesterday killed Elom Oscar Chinonso, a native of Ndiagu Orie, Umuogudu Akpu Ngbo community in Ohaukwu Local Government Area of the Ebonyi State.

The young business man was reportedly killed in his shop by the gunmen who stormed the shop with a branded party Sienna vehicle. The deceased was a supporter of the All Progressive Grand Alliance (APGA).

The party has accused Ebubeagu Security Network of masterminding the killing. This was contained in a statement signed by Director of Media and Publicity of the Professor Bernard Odoh Campaign organisation, Charles Otu and made available to journalists in Abakaliki, the state capital.

"Again, our hearts are severely grieved that the Ebonyi State APC government under the leadership of Engr. David Umahi has continued on its mute mode while watching rampaging Ebubeagu militia kill inno-

cent citizens of our dear state all for power grabbing.

"While calling on the police authorities to now expedite action in arresting those who attacked our governorship candidate's convoy to speedy justice, we also reiterate our persistent calls on the Inspector General of Police, Usman Baba to bring his words to effect that all deadly quasi security outfit like Ebubeagu will not feature or partake in the activities leading to and during and after the February 25 and March 11 general elections in Nigeria," he stated.
