# Drama as police arrest 2 bailiffs in court over killing of village head

**T**here was mild drama at the Minna Senior Magistrate Court 7 over the weekend as two bailiffs who were in the Court to seek and secure the bail of 14 suspects who are standing trial for the killing of the village head of Lamba-

ta, Alhaji Mohammed Abdulsahur, were apprehended and arrested.

The two suspects, Musa Gajima Uztaz and Hon. Danladi Dashi (AKA

Ojukwu), the police said were on the wanted list of suspects at the office of the State Criminal Investigation and Intelligent Department (SCIID), in Minna.

The two suspects were whisked away by the police orderly attached to the Senior Magistrate, Bulus Adam right from the Court room.

They came to the court with the hope of securing the bail of the 14 suspects earlier arrested by the police over their involvement in the killing of the village head.

Musa Gajima Uztaz and Hon. Danladi Dashi were alleged to have sponsored the killing of the late village head along with the suspects

currently standing trial before the Minna Senior Magistrate Court 7.

*New Telegraph* gathered that they were in Court in solidarity with the suspects, apparently to secure their bail with the understanding that the suspects will be granted bail on the resumed hearing slated for February 16, 2023.

When they were sighted in Court however, it was whispered to the police that they were on the police wanted list for their involvement in the killing of the monarch, Alhaji Mohammed Abdulsahur.

The police immediately arrested and whisked them away to the State Criminal Investigation and Intel-

ligent Department (SCIID) headquarters for questioning.

The Police Prosecutor ASP Timothy Peter Irimiya told the senior Magistrate, Fati Kabir that investigations into the matter are still ongoing.

He requested for the adjournment of the case till March 20, 2023 on the ground that the police is still on the trail of other suspects that are still at large.

The presiding Senior Magistrate, Hajiya Fati Kabir then adjourned the case till March 20, 2023 and ordered for the continued remand of the suspects at correctional custody.
