

Police arrest 11 suspects with human parts in Ibadan

1 The Oyo State Police Command has said that it arrested 11 suspects in possession of nine dry human skulls, one fresh human head, intestines and other vital body parts.

SP Adewale Osifeso, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) of the command, who disclosed this yesterday in Ibadan, while briefing journalists, disclosed that the suspects were arrested in their hide-out at Orita-Aperin area of Ibadan, adding that 16 others were arrested in connection with alleged kidnapping and armed robbery.

He explained that discreet intelligence gathering carried out on Feb. 22 by a police monitoring unit uncovered the criminal activities

of the suspects.

He said that the suspects specialised in selling human skulls and other organs for ritual purposes.

The PPRO said that the 11 members of the criminal gang had all confessed to the crime upon interrogations.

He said that the suspects confessed that the dry human skulls were harvested from corpses at burial grounds.

He said they also confessed that the fresh human head and other body organs were harvested from persons after being killed by their kingpin, simply identified as Amuludun who is now at large.

Osifeso said that investigation was now in progress to arrest the

fleeing suspects, adding that further developments would be communicated to the public later.

Meanwhile one of the suspects and wife of the principal suspect now at large, said she knew her husband as an Islamic cleric and was surprised when the human skulls were found in his office.
