

Lagos: Vehicle crushes 2 siblings to death in mother's shop

Two siblings have lost their lives when the driver of a Lexus Jeep lost control and rammed into a shop at the Isolo area of Lagos State, also injuring another.

The driver of the vehicle with registration number LSD 356GU, allegedly lost control and killed the victims.

According to an eyewitness, the two dead children, who were between the ages of 14 and 17, were said to be children of an All Progressives Congress (APC), chieftain in the area.

It was gathered that the two children were playing with some other children in their mother's shop at Number 2, Iyewa Street, off Kogberegbe, Isolo, area of the state, at about 7.40p.m. on Sunday when the incident happened.

The vehicle allegedly rammed into the kiosk in front of the house and the momentum carried it into the rooms. It destroyed the house and injured the children.

The victim were said to have been rushed to Isolo General Hospital, where the two children were confirmed dead on arrival at the hospital.
