

Kaduna imposes curfew as 2 killed in gang clash

The Kaduna State Government has imposed a 24-hour curfew on Sabon Garin Nassarawa-Tirkaniya in

the Chikun Local Government Area following the killing of two people "in an incident of urban gang violence".

In a statement yesterday, the Commissioner for Internal Security and Home Affairs Samuel Aruwan the government took the decision following the breakdown of law and order.

The statement said: "The Kaduna State Government hereby announces the immediate imposition of a 24-hour curfew on Sabon Garin Nassarawa-Tirkaniya area of Chikun LGA.

"This decision was reached following a breakdown of law and order which led to the killing of two citizens in an incident of urban gang violence."

Meanwhile, the state government said three suspects had been arrested in connection with the violence.

According to Aruwan, six persons were injured and are receiving medical attention.
