

Police kill 3 terrorists, kidnappers in Zamfara, Adamawa

The police in Zamfara State have killed two bandits and repelled an attack on a community in the Tsafe Local Government Area.

Also in Adamawa State, the police assisted by hunters killed a suspected kidnapper and rescued two victims in the Toungo Local Government Area on Sunday.

Zamfara police spokesman CSP Muhammad Shehu confirmed this in a statement on Monday.

The Commissioner of Police Kolo Yusuf has commended the resilience of the officers.

He assured residents that the command was very committed to curtailing the resurgence of criminal activities across the state.

"The bandits, who attempted to attack on the community, were repelled, leaving two of the bandits neutralized, while others

fled with possible gunshot wounds.

"The Commissioner of Police also appreciates the joint efforts of the police and military operations to curtail banditry and other criminal activities."

The police urged the public to continue to support security agencies in their efforts to restore lasting peace and security in the state.

Adamawa police spokesman Suleiman Nguroje said in Yola on Monday the killing of the suspected kidnapper was one of the successes of the police's collaborative strategies to end kidnapping, robbery, cattle rustling, and unlawful possession of firearms.

He said: "One kidnapper was neutralised when he and his gang arrived at a spot to receive N2million ransom demanded from relatives of the kidnapped victims."
