Alleged Murder Case: Onasa royal family petitions Lagos CP

The royal family of Onasa and Abatiwa, have accused a popular land grabber, Kamoru Lamina, in Ikorodu of arresting five of their youths and tagging them as cultist who killed a policeman at Emuren area of Lagos State, to cover up a murder case against him. The victims who were accused of being cultists and allegedly killing the policeman are Shakiru Shittu, Taofeek Aluko, Sola Sonaike, Adekunle Onasanya and Muri Aluko, they were arrested by some members of Oodua Peoples Congress (OPC), who are allegedly working for the land grabber.

The accused family members who spoke with our correspondent over the weekend said the popular land grabber in Ikorodu arrested the youths with the assistance of OPC and handed them over to the Police as the killer of the police- man, adding that the victims knew nothing about the murder.

According to the Secretary of Onosa Royal Family, Abraham Maja-Aliko Maya, the land grabber ordered the arrest of the youths and tagged them cultists in order to cover up the murder charges against him, by giving false information to the police about the youths in or- der to divert Police attention from the crime of murder he allegedly committed in Ogun State over land matter. In a petition sighted by our correspondent and signed by their solicitor, Barrister Ayodeji Adekunle, read in parts: "A case of giving false information to the police, an attempt to cover up murder case under investigation at the Ogun State Police Command, blackmail and intimidation."

According to the solicitors, "The main plank of our brief is that

these notorious land grabbers in Ikorodu led by one Kamoru Lamina, Alias Sir K, Mukaila Salaudeen (a.k.a Actor) Biola Emmanuel a.k.a Stainless, Adekunle Onanowo a.k.a Olutasin, Nosiru Ajagbe, Lamina Shodende, Chief Jimoh Balogun(Bale Of Odo – Onosa), Segun Dada, Kamoru Lamina, Adewale Ogunniyi, among others invaded our clients land at Abatiwa and unleashed terror leading to the death of two people.

"The two dead people are Kamoru Anifowoshe and Akibu Akinsiku. After killing Kamoru Anifowoshe these heartless people cut off his two hands. We have the medical report and photographs." However, reacting to the allegations, Kamoru Lamina alias Sir K said he has nothing to do with those arrested by the police and the OPC.

He said the Onasa Royal Family should visit the Lagos State Police Command to clear themselves about the murder of the policeman that they killed and took away his riffle.
