

Troops kill 7 bandits, arrest others in Zamfara

Troops of Operation Hadarin Daji on Saturday neutralised seven terrorists, apprehended two others and destroyed several of their camps in Zurmi Local Government Area of Zamfara State.

The Director, Defence

Madia Operations, Maj.-Gen. Musa Danmadami, made this known in a statement yesterday in Abuja.

Danmadami said the troops achieved the feat during an encounter with the bandits at Birnin Tsaba, Tsanu, Lamba, Gabas, Gidan

Kaso, and Dumburum Forest in Zurmi Local Government Area of the state.

He said the troops recovered seven motorcycles, two empty AK 47 magazines and one Baofeng radio.

According to him, following the arrest of a terrorist informant on April 21, troops conducted a follow-up operation and arrested another two terrorists at Shinkafi town in Shinkafi Local Government Area.

"Items recovered from the suspects include one motorcycle and three mobile phones.

"The military high command commends troops of Operation HADARIN DAJI and encourages the general public to avail troops with credible and timely information on criminal activities," he said.

Hotelier, one other arrested for car theft in Ogun

The Ogun State Police Command has arrested a 47-year-old hotelier, Paul Niwa and one Michael Odunayo for allegedly stealing a bus.

The vehicle, a T4 Volkswagen bus with registration number AAB 22 XB belongs to a Logistics Transport Company in Sagamu area of the state.

The suspects were arrested on Friday, April 21

the Abeokuta-Sagamu Expressway.

But, when he got to where the vehicle was parked, the following morning, the bus was no longer there and all efforts to find it proved abortive.

"Upon the report, the DPO, Ewu-Oliwo division, CSP Toyosi Bello, detailed detectives to unravel those behind the disappearance of the said vehicle.
