It was learnt that the rescue operation was led by one Akanji Wasiu (Bravo 16) who confirmed that the accident involved three

vehicles, a Mazda commercial bus with registration number FKJ 88 XH.a Commercial Tricycle marked KJA369QManda white Camry car marked KJA 351 HG, on main carriage way at Iyana-Ipaja area of Lagos. Taofiq said during preliminary investigation it was discovered that the driver of the white Camry car lost control due to over speeding and hit a commercial tricycle from the rear while the tricycle went off balance and obstructed another on coming, fully loaded Mazda com-

mercial bus, going to Iyana-Ipaja.

The rescued victims were immediately rushed to the Hospitals, unfortunately one of the rescued accident victim, died while being rushed to the hospital.

"Those vehicles involved in the accident were immediately removed from the road to avoid impeding free flow of traffic and the man from whom diapers were recovered was handed over to the Police from Gowon Estate Divisional Police Headquarters for further investigations.

Reacting to the incident, the

LASTMA General Manager Mr Bolaji Oreagba, stated that it was a man-made accident which could have been prevented if over-speed. ing was avoided.

He, however, maintained that the government had embarked on regular public education on danger inherent in over-speeding by both private commercial and truck driv. ers across the state.

My Oreagba however warned all motoring public to always ensure that their vehicles are in good condition, particularly the brake before driving them on Lagos mads
