

Police arrest OPC member for alleged murder

The Ondo State Police Command has arrested a member of the Oodua People's Congress (OPC) for allegedly killing a prince of the Akure kingdom, Prince Adesoji Adesida.

The suspect, Rafiu Akinwale, a member of the OPC, also known as 'Slow' was said to have beaten Prince Adesida to death in Akure.

It was learnt that Akinwale who came to a funeral was seen beating his girlfriend over an accusation that she was exchanging mobile numbers with another man.

It was also gathered that an attempt by the victim to prevent Akinwale from beating his girlfriend did not go down well with him (Akinwale) who out of anger pushed the victim.

An eyewitness said that as Akinwale pushed the victim, he hit his head on the wall and was rushed to a hospital. The witness said the victim was however confirmed dead at the hospital where he was rushed to.
