

4 Bayelsa supporters' club members die in auto crash in Delta

Tragedy struck in Delta State yesterday as four members of the Bayelsa State supporters club died in an auto crash and seven others now receiving treatment at the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) of the Asaba Specialist Hospital.

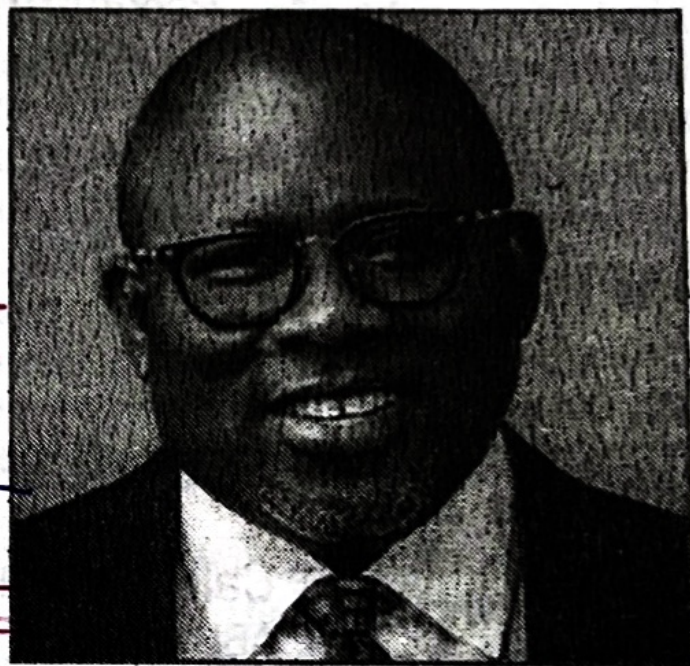
One of the buses of the supporters club was said to have crashed into the bush at Kwale in Ndokwa West Local Government Area of the state.

Delta State Governor Sheriff Oborevwori visited the victims to sympathise with the survivors.

The team was traveling to Asaba, the Delta State capital for the Women FA cup Championship Final, held at the Late Stephen Keshi Stadium.

The victims died on the spot while others sustained various degrees of injuries.

The Public Relations Officer (PRO) of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Asaba Sector Com-

mand, Miss Victoria, said she wasn't aware of the development.

The Governor was received by the Bayelsa State Commissioner for Sports, Mr Daniel Igali, the Secretary to the Delta State Government (SSG), Dr Kingsley Emu and Chief of Staff to the Governor, Hon. Johnson Erijo.

The Chief Medical Director of the hospital, Dr Peace Ighosewe, who conducted the Governor round the male and female surgical wards to see the casualties, explained how the emergency situation was handled.
