"The women were stripped naked and beaten mercilessly by the mob over the allegation of witchcraft as a result of which two of them were brutally murdered."

The Commissioner of Police, CP Babatola who expressed shock over the unprofessional conduct displayed by the said Inspector, Ahmed Suleiman as well as the vigilante members as shown in the viral video.

"Irked by the unfortunate incident, the Commissioner

immediately deployed the Deputy Commissioner of Police who arrested those seen maltreating and assaulting the women."
