Shootout: Police Kill 3 Suspected Robbers In Delta

Three daredevil armed robbers that engaged police in gun duel at along Ugborikoko/Giwa-Amu airport road Warri, have been killed. The suspects opened fire on the operatives attached to 'B' Division Warri, when they acted on a distress call about their operation along the airport road.

The Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Bright Edafe in Asaba yesterday said that the hoodlums operated in an unregistered black Toyota Corolla car.

He said "the police squad raced to the scene, and when the hoodlums sighted the advancing police team, they fired gun shots at them and the team retaliated, engaged them in a serious gun duel during which three of the hood- lums were fatally wounded."

He said that other members of the gang escaped with bullet wounds, but that the injured suspects gave up the ghost, while they were being taken to the hospital.

He listed the items recovered from them to include one cut-to-size locally fabricated gun, two live cartridges, the unregistered Toyota car, and eight different vehicle keys. He said that manhunt for the fleeing gang members has been enhanced.
