2 die as bandits attack Rock FM corporate office in Jalingo

wo members of a robbery gang reportedly died after they attacked the corporate office of Rock FM, Jalingo, Taraba State at the Malam Joda Area of the state capital in the late hours of Friday July 21, in the early hours of Saturday.

According to a statement by the Head of Programmes, Rock FM 92.3 FM, Jalingo, Ahmad Umar Gassol, the hoodlums descended on the premises of the4 young radio station "carting away several items while the CEO, Oloye Ayodele Samuel was in one of the offices and at the verge of being attacked, but was rescued without any injury by the joint intervention of the DSS and the Nigerian Army in response to a distress call.

"The raid has left our CEO traumatised, although grateful to God and the security operatives for their timely intervention in which two of the attackers didn't make it alive. "Some of the items stolen are: Two LG Television (43 and 50 inches), three UPS (3kva and one KVA), 8 channel Digital Audio Mixer, five computer Monitors, one compact Dell system (all in one), four Microphone stands 7 Four Computer hybrid CPUs, SKVA Generator."

Other items lost to the hoodlums include, "bunch of wires, including VGA and HDMI cables, computer Keyboards, two ways Monitor speakers, bag of broadcasting connectors and headsets, sets of Office Chairs and an air bed."

While urging members of the public cooperate with them in recovering these items "as they are critical to our operations," Gassol added, "We appeal to the general public to kindly report anyone found with these items to the nearest security agency and in the same vein implore the general public to be security conscious and report suspicious activities in your neighbourhood.
